CHAPTER- 1

1. INTRODUCTION

Social Welfare and Women Empowerment Department is implementing various welfare schemes to children, women, senior citizen and transgender covering their nutrition, safety, socio-economic security, etc. through the Directorate of Social Welfare, the Directorate of Children Welfare and Special Services and the Directorate of Integrated Child Development Services. This Department act as a Nodal Agency for various Social Security Pension Schemes which is being implemented by the Commissioner of Revenue Administration.

Welfare Schemes like Pudhumai Penn Scheme, Tamil Pudalvan Scheme, Chief Minister Breakfast Scheme, Marriage Assistance, Girl Child Protection, Nutritious Meal Programme and Sticking of Uniforms to School Children are implemented by the Directorate of Social Welfare. In order to protect the destitute, deserted women, young girls rescued from child marriage, Service Homes established in six districts. There are 28 Working Women Hostels maintained in order to give safe and secured living places with all amenities and hygienic food at reasonable cost for working women coming from distant places to work in district headquarters and industrial areas.

In order to give self-employment, economic independence to women, 98 Women Tailoring Industrial Co-operative Societies and one Transgender Tailoring Society are established. Senior Citizens and Transgender are also benefited by various welfare schemes which lead them to live a respectful and dignified life.

Under Puratchi Thalaivar MGR Nutritious Meal programme, 48.51 lakh school children from standard 1 to 10 are being given hot, nutritious variety and tasty food. In Integrated Child Development Services, the children from birth to 6 years, the pregnant and lactating mothers are also provided nutritious food, preschool education and health education.

Necessary assistance made available under various schemes implemented by the Directorate of Children Welfare and Special Services to the Children and Women who are in need of care and protection with legal conflicts.

Social legislations to protect children, women and senior citizens like Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, Commission for Protection of Child Right Act, 2005 Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006, Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO), Protection of Women from Sexual Harassment at Workplace Act, 2013, Tamil Nadu Hostels and Homes for Women and Children (Regulations) Act, 2014 and Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 and the Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019 are implemented and monitored by the Department of Social Welfare and Women Empowerment.

3. Nutritious Meal Programme

3 (a) Chief Minister's Breakfast Scheme (CMBFS)

Tamil Nadu is a pioneer State in the country in launching the Chief Minister's Breakfast Scheme with an objective to increase the enrolment in schools and also empower women by providing employment opportunities. In order to combat malnutrition and improve the nutritional status of children, the Breakfast scheme for the year 2022- 2023 was announced in the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly under rule 110 on 07.05.2022 and was launched as a pilot scheme in Madurai district on 15.7.2022, benefiting 1.15 lakh students studying in 1545 Government schools from 1st to 5th standard in the Greater Chennai Corporation, other Corporations, Municipalities, Village Panchayats and Hill Areas.

Subsequently, the Chief Minister's Breakfast Scheme was extended to the remaining Government primary schools in the Corporation and Municipal areas on 1.3.2023. Later, this scheme was expanded to cover 1853798 children in all 31008 Government primary schools functioning in Urban and Rural Areas from 25.8.2023. Further, the Chief Minister's Breakfast Scheme was extended to 2.20 lakh children studying in 3995 Government aided primary schools in rural areas on 15.7.2024.

Objectives.

The Objective of the scheme is to ensure that children attend school without hunger, enhance the Nutritional status of the children particularly in preventing Anemia, increase the attendance / learning skills of the children in the schools and to decrease the burden of the working mothers

During second and fourth week of a month on Thursday, 20 gm of Green gram is provided to each child in the form of "Sundal", which provides 67.0 kcal of energy and 4.80 gm of protein. VIII. On all Fridays to increase the carbohydrate content, children are provided with 20 gms of chilly fried potato, which has 19.04 kcal of energy and 0.32 gms of protein. The amount for the procurement of 20 gm of potato has been enhanced from 16 paise to 40 paise. IX. In order to address iodine and iron deficiency among children, Double Fortified Salt is used for cooking. X. Sweet Pongal is served to children by using Jaggery and Ghee on Perinthalaivar Kamarajar, Perarignar Anna, Kalaignar M. Karunanithi, Puratchi Thalaivar M.G.R., and Puratchi Thalaivi J. Jayalalitha birthdays. XI. Fortified rice supplied by TNCSC is being used in all Nutritious Meal Centres from October 2021.

CHAPTER - 4

I. INTEGRATED CHILD DEVELOPMENT SERVICES SCHEME

The Government of Tamil Nadu is taking various measures to meet the nutritional and health needs of Children below 6 years of age, pregnant women, lactating mothers and Adolescent girls. The project works have been extended to all parts of Tamil Nadu in such a way that no beneficiary is left behind even in less accessible areas.

The scheme is implemented through 54,449 anganwadi centres (49,509 main anganwadi centres and 4,940 mini anganwadi centres) functioning under 434 ICDS projects. Out of these, 385 are Rural projects, 47 are Urban projects and 2 are Tribal projects.

II. OBJECTIVES

1. To lay foundation for the proper psychological, physical and social development of children.
2. To improve nutritional and health status of children below six years.
3. To reduce incidence of mortality, morbidity, malnutrition and school dropouts.
4. To achieve effective coordination of policy and implementation.
5. To enhance the capabilities of the mother to look after the normal health and nutritional needs of child through proper nutrition and health education.
6. To make Anganwadi Centres as Vibrant Early Childhood Development centres.

POSHAN Abhiyaan

Union Government has set up the National Nutrition Mission with the goal of improving nutritional status of children

from 0-6 years, pregnant women and lactating mothers. The scheme has specific targets for reducing stunting, anemia, undernutrition, and low birth weight.

In 2021, the Union Government has launched the Poshan Tracker Mobile Phone Application to obtain a comprehensive overview of service delivery at Anganwadi Centres. It enables data entry and real-time monitoring of providing supplementary nutrition to beneficiaries, growth monitoring of children, and other essential aspects. All 54,449 Anganwadi Centres are registered in this application, ensuring thorough coverage and tracking.

V. PRE SCHOOL EDUCATION

Pre school education is imparted to 2 to 5+ years children. The objectives of the pre-school education is to promote holistic development of the child through play way method and thematic method of learning for smooth transition to primary education. Two sets of unisex uniforms made of baniyan cloth are provided to pre school children. Pre-School Kits are provided Anganwadi Centres every year.

VI. ANGANWADI EMPLOYEES

The Anganwadi employees working in 54,449 Anganwadi centres are provided with special time scale of pay. The allowances like Dearness allowance, House Rent Allowance, City Compensatory Allowance, Medical Allowance, Hill Allowance and Winter Allowance are provided to them along with annual increment. The Anganwadi employees are eligible for lumpsum grant at the time of retirement, Rs.1,00,000/- is being paid to Anganwadi Workers and Mini Anganwadi Workers and Rs.50,000 /- to Anganwadi Helpers with effect from 01.10.2017. The Anganwadi Workers including Mini Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers are paid a special pension of Rs.2,000/- on their retirement from 01.10.2017. Every year, all Anganwadi employees are being provided two sarees with waist Coat as uniform.

- Mothers are requested to come to the centre and take the weight of the child.
- Nutrition and health services are provided to all children in the Anganwadi Centre irrespective of caste/creed/religion/income/profession etc.
- Adolescent Girls (14-18 years) are also weighed in the Anganwadi centre in aspirational districts of Virudunagar and Ramnathapuram.
- Community participation in the Project activities are invited.
- All working group members such as Women Working Groups, Adolescent Girls Working Group, Community Working Group can participate in the monthly education sessions, Village Health Sanitation and Nutrition Day, Children's Day and various other celebrations being organized every month by Anganwadi Workers.
